Around fifty participants including staff members of the Regional Centre and local LSCs attended the programme.



IGNOU launches Certificate Programme in First Aid



School of Health Sciences, IGNOU has developed a Certificate Programme in First Aid to help individuals / people in dealing with emergencies, accidents and acutely arising health situations. The programme is open to varied target group with minimum qualification of 10th pass. The minimum duration of the programme is six months.

The programme will benefit those who wish to pursue careers in which first aid training and certification is necessary for recruitment like assistants and aides working in nursing homes, mobile ambulances, industries, construction sites, sports coaches, physical education instructors, Police / Army personnel, teachers in schools, etc., and for those whose organizations have made it mandatory for their workers to undergo first aid training.
